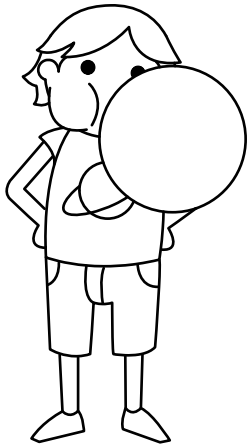


HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE FOR WASTE TO DECOMPOSE?



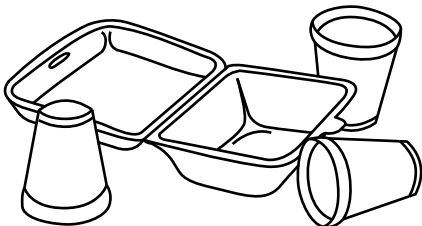
A chewing gum doesn't dissolve for 5 years.



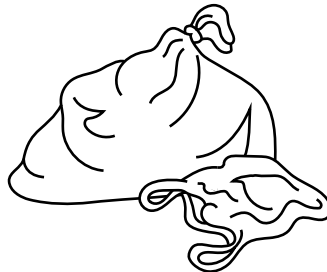
A glass bottle will last for more than 3000 years.



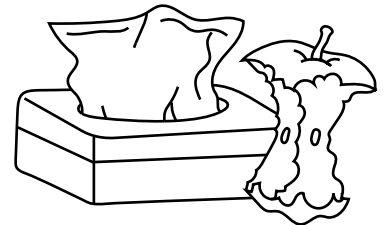
It takes 500 years for a can to disappear.



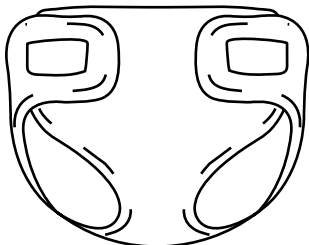
Polystyrene is a special plastic that lasts 1000 years.

Fruits and paper tissues disappear completely in 3 months.



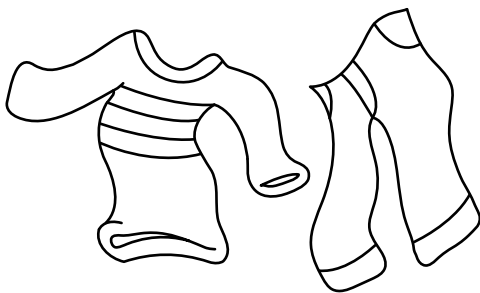
Baby diapers take 500 years.



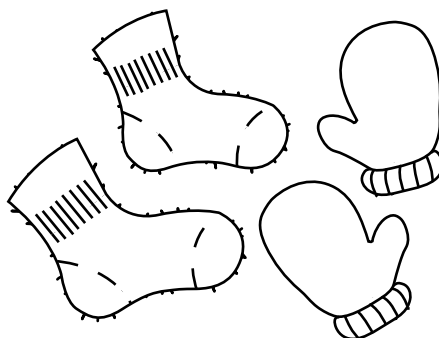
A plastic bottle takes 100 to 1000 years to decompose.
